PRIVACY STATEMENT

OCS recognizes that individuals with whom we conduct business value their privacy. However, in order to conduct global business in this increasingly electronic economy, the collection of personal information is often necessary and desirable. It is OCS' goal to balance the benefits of e-commerce with the right of individuals to prevent the misuse of their personal information.

Collection of your Personal Information

OCS reserves the right to collect personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address, telephone number, anonymous demographic information, that is not unique to you, such as your ZIP code, age, gender, preferences, interests and favorites.

OCS does not associate sensitive data, such as your race, religion, or political affiliations, with personally identifiable information. OCS takes precautions to segregate any sensitive data you may provide that reference your race, religion, sexual orientation, ethnicity or political affiliations.

OCS encourages you to review the privacy statements of Web sites you choose to link to from OCS so that you can understand how those Web sites collect, use and share your information. OCS is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on Web sites outside of the OCS Web sites.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by OCS. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times, operating system, platform type and referring Web site addresses. OCS uses this information for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the OCS Web sites.

Use of your Personal Information

OCS Web sites collect and use your personal information to operate OCS Web sites and deliver the services you have requested. OCS sites also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from OCS. OCS may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

OCS does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. In addition, OCS may share data with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to OCS, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

OCS keeps track of the Web sites and pages our customers visit within OCS, in order to determine what OCS information is the most popular.

OCS Web sites will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on OCS or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of OCS; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of OCS, its web sites, or the public.

Children and Privacy. OCS requests that children under the age of 13 not to send any personally identifiable information to OCS websites without the consent of their parents or guardians. OCS will not knowingly collect, use, or disclose to third parties any personal information collected from children, and is committed to complying with applicable laws and requirements, such as the United States' Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA).

Collecting Domain Information. OCS also collects domain information as part of its analysis of the use of this site. This data enables us to become more familiar with which customers visit our site, how often they visit and what parts of the site they visit most often. OCS uses this information to improve its web-based offerings. This information is collected automatically and requires no action on your part.

Use of Cookies

The OCS Web sites use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a Web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is site registration and to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, then some pages may not fully function and you may not be able to access certain information on this site.
